

Lord High Sheriff's Tournament of the Sword Rules

1. All participants must sign a liability form.
2. Competition is open to only Renaissance Festival participants, 13 years and older.
3. Entry Fee is \$2.00 (Non Refundable) This will go for prizes and to support the Fencing Booth.
4. All weapons must be approved by the Tournament Director.
5. All competitors must wear rather sturdy leather gloves with cuffs, to be worn in the ring, and approved by the Ringmaster.
6. Padded jacket will be available for all competitors. Protective body cover is strongly recommended.
7. Shoes must be worn by all competitors.
8. Any competitor may be required to leave the ring at the discretion of the Ringmaster. Entry fee will not be refunded.
9. By order of the Lord High Sheriff no shall forsake duties of the Realm in order to prepare or participate in this tournament.
10. ^{the} Two levels of competition will be Squire and Knight? ^{Tip few Squires become Knights:} Format
1. Standard ballon fencing rules apply. Competitors will keep their unarmed hand behind their back at all times. They will start on the Ringmaster's command, and halt at the Ringmaster's command. Valid target are the opponent's ballons only.

3. Placement for Double elimination is at the sole discretion of the Tournament Director.
4. Awards go to the first three places.
- 4 1/2. There will be 2 rounds - levels → the squire level and the Knight level.
5. Registration is open until 6:30 PM Saturday, September 4, 1993
6. Competition will begin proptly at 7:15 PM Saturday, Sept. 4, 1993
- 6 1/2. Competition for those not eliminated on the first night will continue on Sunday, Sept. 5, 1993.
7. Competitors not present at the begining of their match will be eliminated.
8. There will be no coaching during bouts.
9. Gentleman's/Ladies rules apply - no leaning back during bouts! Face your opponents - don't look to the
