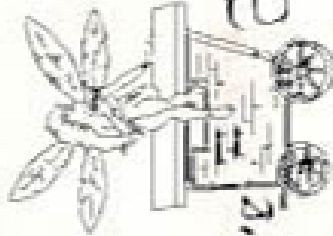

To whom it may not concern:

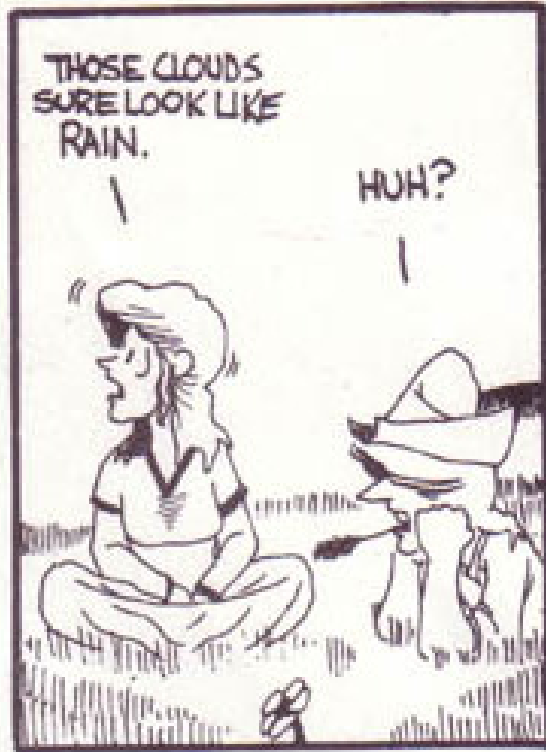
