And thanks to others who submitted articles at cast call. Some of whom did not sign their names.

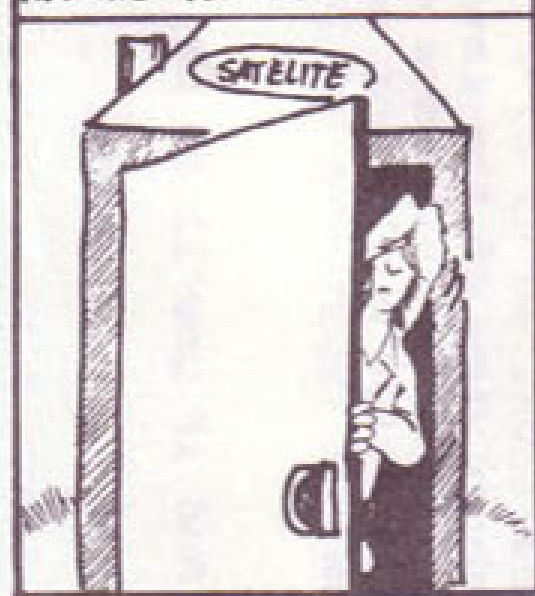
