



Renaissance Revelry


The Minnesota Renaissance Festival is the reproduction of an authentic 16th century European marketplace on harvest holiday. The cultures and customs of many lands are represented on a rolling, wooded 200 acres in the Minnesota River Valley, the

largest outdoor theatre in the midwest.

Twenty-five miles southwest of the Twin Cities on Highway 169, floating banners beckon the traveler down Renaissance Lane. 
The Renaissance Festival provides an educational and cultural experience that is exciting and enjoyable for both adults and children.
