As the Minnesota Renaissance Festival comes to a close in a week or so, we'd like to take this opportunity to offer you three subscription options, since face to face delivery is about to become very impractical.

As the news spreads throughout the Realm, so does fashion. One particular style is creating such public displays of flaunting and flogging that I felt required to research and address it - that is the common desire of youth to bare various areas of skin in a provocative manner! Such infamy!

The costumers primary source of fashion correctness is paintings from the era - due to the Renaissance artists' meticulous eye for detail and accuracy - so there I begin.

Paging through the stacks in my home library I came upon Carpaccio's *The Courtesans*, 1510. This low-necked, exposing the shoulder gown should be the standard for wanton women - but wait, Leonardo's *Madonna with St. Anne*, 1510, religion's leading lady, is similarly attired in such revealing apparel! Titian painted in 1536 *La Bella* - AKA *Portrait of a Lady* - exposing shoulder, neck, and cleavage. Such cheek! Or perhaps the southern climate for these ladies required a more northern exposure.

But wait - the German Lucas Cranach (1472-1533) documents a definite off the shoulder style in *Judith with the Head of Holofernes*. (Holofernes is the one with the off the body attire). And Holbein's wife shows cleavage and shoulder, his child has an off shoulder chemise with elbow length sleeves in his *Portraits of the Artist's Wife with Katherina and Philipp*, 1528. Where were the Fashion Police?

The target of this festival's fashion intervention is lovely young wenches, daring temptresses, that expose their provocative shoulders and upper arms in a very saucy fashion. But certainly no less revealing as Hendrick Terbruggen's biblical reenactment of *Jacob, Laban, and Leah*, 1588. Of course the subject of substituting one sister for another in a bridal bed is scandalous, but I don't think the attire reflects intentional wantonness. The girls just want to have fun!

Exhausting my library, I decided to relax with a Renaissance classic from Renaissance Films, Branagh's version of Will Shakespeare's *Much Ado About Nothing*. The lovely ladies dance and cavort in muslin corsets and chemises, some sleeveless, all busty, and the lead ladies exposing arms, shoulders, and more. But what fun they have, and how lovely, pure and innocent it all seems!

To research the re-creation of Renaissance dress, I reviewed the California Pleasure Faire's publicity publication. This event sets the highest standards for dress, and its participant and patrons exhibit this. There it is - arms, breasts, shoulders, the works.

Before I will begin to preach on the do's and don't's of the dress for this Festival, I will research, then reflect on the theme of this event: a RE-creation NOT a re-enactment of the Renaissance. Dress enhances your involvement, develops your

character, and is a whole lot of fun - witness the Fops, Madame Bovine, the Unicorn, and many others.


The creative force of thousands have attired the Renaissance Festivals in brilliant designs, hues, and expression. In our search for improving our authenticity, let us not forget about beauty, creativity, and enhancement of character and theme. And that girls just want to have fun! ☺
