Safety Services is charged with ensuring that the only people on site are individuals who have purchased tickets, or authorized participants with exercity Sec. (D.

You are to carry your Site 1.D. (also known as your pass) on your person at all times, and display it at any time a Safety Services officer asks you to.

You will be asked to show it during show hours when you attempt to enter or exis the site via exy participant access point. You may also be asked to show a pass when your vehicle drives anto festival property on Chestnut Boulevard at the "Back Gate." Additionally, Safety Services typically performs a site sweep at the end of every festival day to ensure that all pottoms have departed, and the only personnel remaining on site are outborized participants.

Cooperation with the pass process is manufactly if some such as it have it permisently difficult to my booth", "I haven't gatter one yet," or "You haven't gatter one yet," or "You have who it one," or any other access or not valid recessor to fall to show a pass. You are encouraged to consider weering your pass on a lamyard or chair to keep it visible during the sweep process and easily accessible of all firms. Please note, the compareum has additional posts requirement not delineated here. For your reference, the official crafter rule regarding passes is below.
