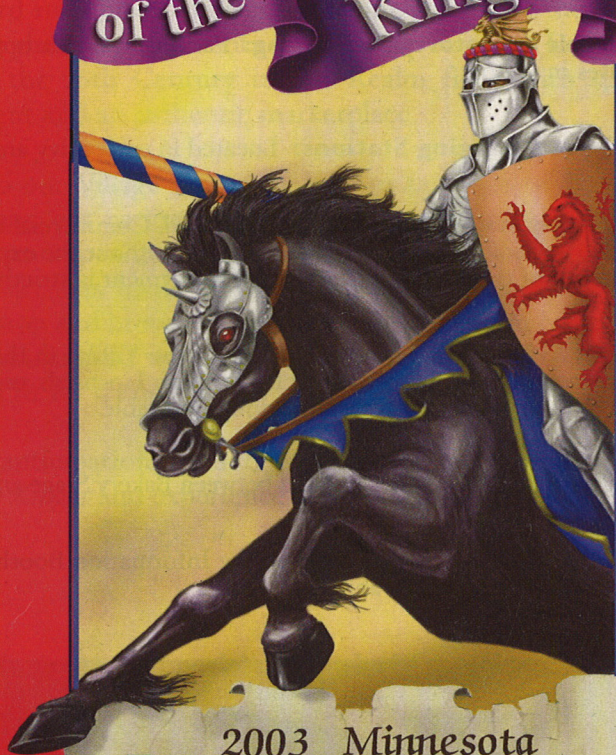



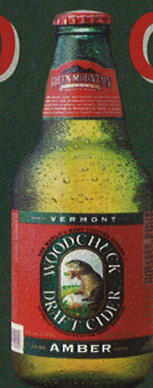

ROYAL WINE TASTING

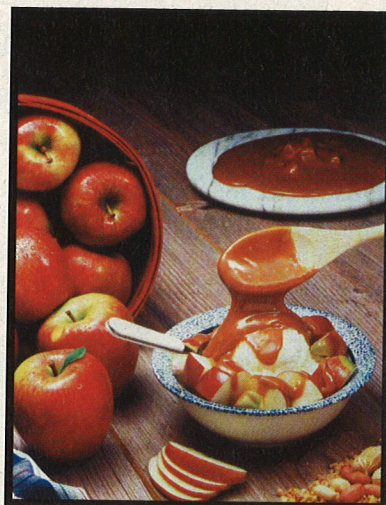

Katie Beery began her work with the Minnesota Renaissance Festival at the Hall of Scribes in 1982. Soon after, Kris MacDonald, while visiting the Festival as a patron, made a casual inquiry about the possibility of working at the Festival as a calligrapher. That first meeting turned into an enduring friendship that is now in its 22nd season!

Known to their majesties as Folio Scriptoria and Verso Feathervain, both have studied their craft for more than 25 years! Among the notable Master Artists from whom they have taken instructions are Donald Jackson, Scribe to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth of England, Sheila Waters and Mark Van Stone, all internationally known calligraphers and authors. The Minnesota Renaissance Festival honored Folio and Verso 5 years ago when the title of "Master Artist" was conferred upon them.

Together, Kate and Kris have created a line of calligraphic works that feature words and text with an intellectual appeal. Many of their pieces feature historic elements such as medieval illumination, Celtic knotwork, and a wide variety of lettering styles including Gothic, Uncial Italic. In their modern lives, both artists operate home studios in the Twin Cities area where they share commercial projects and joint retail opportunities.

"There is a certain artistic potential in every letter, word or phrase the eye can see. As calligraphers, our job is to present an expression of that potential in a way that will inspire the viewer."

Bear Paw Paper Works - Shop 408

Bill and Linda Sumner

Creating their art together has been a way of life for the "BearPaws", Bill and Linda Sumner, since their college days at the University of Minnesota over thirty years ago. Their two sons, Josh and Jake, have grown up on the artfair circuit which began as a part-time business and grew into a full-time operation in 1987. Since that time they have shown their wares at many venues across the U.S. including the Minnesota Renaissance Festival.

Bill and Linda now live in the Central Minnesota woods with their eight white-tail deer, two Scottish Terriers, Dalmatian and two cats. They find their inspiration from the many sources that surround them in their woods... all these things are then realized in Bear Paw Paper "works of art."

Bill, the official papermaker, enjoys experimenting with leaves, pine-needles, perennial and wildflowers, tree bark and anything else he finds walking on one of the many nature trails in their backyard. He adds these "finds" to his blend of cotton linters and pulp recipe. Other man-made ingredients are added to the pulp vat along with non-toxic dyes for added color and texture. Before the Bear Paw Paper is dry, additional materials are embedded into it before it is "screened" or hand-pressed into clay molds created by Linda.

When the paper is finally dry, Linda further embellishes it with waxed linen, beads, deer-antler buttons, sticks, twigs and natural stones. The Bear Paw collages become three-dimensional with abstract nature, landscapes and flora and fauna themes. Cutting, tearing, folding, layering, stitching and painting add even more texture before the final assembly where an acrylic sealer is used to preserve the piece. Matting and framing are the final steps before they make their way to be displayed in homes, offices and places throughout the planet.

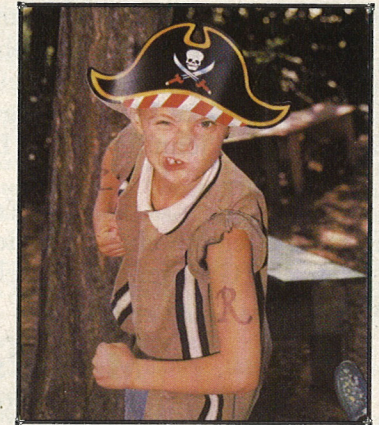

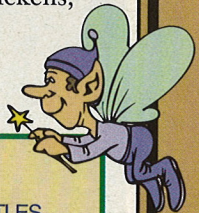
