## ROYAL HIGH TEA



# Artisan Demonstrations

Minnesota Renaissance Festival artisans are the finest to be found in any kingdom. They educate and entertain by sharing knowledge and demonstrating skills. Watch, listen and ask questions! Listed below are those who are sharing the love of their craft. Demonstration times can be found in the News of the Realm or at the Information Booth.

**BLACKSMITHING:** A blacksmithing duo, master and apprentice, demonstrate techniques of metalworking as it would have been performed as early as the 10th century. No modern tools used here! RAVENSMITHS (Shop P-43)

**BOOTS AND SHOES:** Hand designed and handmade before your eyes. A craft and product that's timeless. BEAVER TRACKS (Shop #744)

**BRASS RUBBING:** Create your own keepsake from the past. Replicas of brasses dating from English Medieval to the Renaissance periods are used. The technique of rubbing is demonstrated and explained. BRASSWOOD (Shop #744)

**CALLIGRAPHY:** Take a quill pen in hand and try your skills at writing the Gothic alphabet. Free classes offered three times daily. HALL OF SCRIBES (Shop #1205 at the Water Wheel)

**DRAWING:** Artist shares her technique of charcoal rendering and finger shading through a structured series of practice. You work along side creating a portrait with your own hands in 20 minutes. DRAW ALONG WITH NAN C (Shop P-14)

**ENGRAVING:** Take a brief history lesson, touching on relief prints, intaglio and engraving. The audience assists in the authentic process of creating an engraved print. COCK-N-DAGGER (Shop # 215-216)

**GAMES:** You'll enjoy the history of these handcrafted games. Play them yourself or watch. Either way, you'll be thoroughly entertained. MACGREGOR GAMES (Shop # 636-637)

# Renaissance Master

## Taylor Jewelry- Shop 127 Paul and Marnee Taylor

Paul and Marnee Taylor started making jewelry 28 years ago. They worked as street artists in San Francisco and sold their work at the Embarcadero Plaza and the Fisherman's wharf. They began selling their work at the Minnesota Renaissance Festival in 1988.

The Taylors blend their artistic and technical talents to create *folk* detailed pieces. They hand-cut each piece of sterling silver and various colors of 14 K gold into their own designs.

Paul and Marnee do all of their work freehand. They use techniques such as piercing, engraving, nitric acid etching, riveting, soldering, forming and stone setting to create their jewelry.

Nature is the primary inspiration to these self-taught crafters. Their many years of travel through Asia and the Middle East have also influenced their work. Each piece of jewelry is handcrafted individually and signed by the Taylors.

Paul and Marnee reside in San Francisco, CA, when they are now selling their work at various festivals. They have three children who have grown up traveling to fairs with them.

The Taylors have won awards for their jewelry in five states. They have been featured on the cover of "Sunshine Artist" and advertising posters for several fairs and festivals.



# Renaissance Master

## The Olde Glass Factory- Shop 724 • Eddie Hesairoad

Eddie Hesairoad started designing and building stained glass windows as a hobby in 1975. He turned his talent into a business in 1979, when he opened The Olde Glass Factory Studio. Eddie he first sold his products at the Minnesota Renaissance Festival in 1981.

Hesairoad's desire to carry on his great-grandfather's appreciation of wildlife has inspired much of his work. All of his work is copper foiled, which is the Tiffany-style and allows for more detail. He designs his own patterns, however, he does welcome custom work.

Hesairoad lives on his family farm in Greene, Iowa. He does his work in the new studio he built at the farm. Hesairoad has two daughters, Kris and Kim. Kim has her own booth at the Renaissance Festival in Colorado selling her fused glass jewelry and lampshades.

"Quality instead of quantity" is Hesairoad's advice to beginners in the stained glass field.

## Wizard Wax Works- Shop 206 • Dan Hirssig

Dan Hirssig has been a sculptor and candle-maker for 29 years. The Minnesota Renaissance Festival has provided a perfect setting for him to sell his fantasy wax sculptures. This will be his 26th year with the festival.

Hirssig began wax sculpting after college at a craft shop in Old Hayward, Wis. His college degree in zoology gave him an understanding of animal shapes, which developed into the mystical characters he sculpts today. Dragons, wizards and unicorns are just a few of Hirssig's masterpieces.

Each step of the wax sculpture is done by hand. Wooden dowels are dipped into vats of liquid wax until there are 75 colorful layers. Hirssig squeezes and cuts into the wax in front of a heat lamp to create each form and then cools the sculpture in water to retain its shape. It took many years of practice for Hirssig to achieve the color combinations and detail in the work he exhibits today.

Hirssig lives in Menomonie, Wis., where he works as a chiropractor. His wife, Sondra, has done much of the "behind the scenes" work at Wizard Wax Works. Their daughters, Amber and Alicia, also have an interest in candle-making. They are now doing their own shows to provide income while they attend college.
