August 12 & 13 Events:

Weather: Saturday the weather was extremely hot and muggy with temperatures in the 90's. There was a beautiful downpour in the mid-afternoon followed by more sunshine and mugginess. On Sunday, a cool breeze came and went and the temperatures were a little lower than on Saturday.

Gypsies in Action: Saturday morning seemed to find most of us helter skelter meeting up in the afternoon and then again later in the evening. Sunday was apparently the day of separation of the family.

- Nickoli was in another village performing in the evenings and was unavailable on Saturday and made an appearance on Sunday (until he was 'grounded' by Bryn as he wasn't even walking straight any more).
- Bryn found herself as a brief stand-in squire for Don Quixote (any detail Bryn?).
- Magpie and Auntie Tassels taught some patrons basic belly dance moves in order to have them perform, as a distraction, for the Mayor and his Entourage as they were on their 10am walkabout.
