cal times. The original plucked psalteries were found in a variety of shapes, but it was the triangular form that lent itself most readily to being bowed. This seems to have occurred within the innovative atmosphere of the European Renaissance.

Some Questions about the Bowed Psalter

How can I learn faire-folk to play it?

Since it's so easy to play by ear, most people are playing their first tune in a matter of minutes. Making use of our thorough instruction book and tape, you can be playing many familiar tunes in a few weeks.

What music can you play on it?

The psaltery is primarily a melody instrument and its unusually clear sound lends itself to many styles of music. Ours has thirty strings and is tuned chromatically. It spans two and a half octaves and can be easily played in any key.

What comes with it?

Included with your psaltery is a bow, rosin, extra strings, tuning wrench, note guide, a 24-page instruction book with 20 tunes and a 45-minute cassette tape with tuning on one side and tunes on

the other. All of this fits nicely in an attractive cardboard carrying box.

What about tuning?

Under normal conditions, the psaltery needs tuning only once or twice a year. You can tune it yourself using our simple instructions, or, if you'd prefer, a music store will usually tune it for a folk.com nominal fee.

What if a string breaks?

This rarely happens, but extra strings are provided and the book shows you how to change one. This size string is commonly used on guitars or banjos and is available at most music stores.

How long will the bow last?

Your bow is haired with a durable synthetic developed for violin bows and should last many years under normal use. We rehair bows for \$8 and new ones are \$20.

What woods do you use?

The warm dark wood seen on the sides is select Northern cherry, as is the rosette and bow. Because of its superior tone quality we make our tops of quartersawn Sitka spruce, which has been the soundboard choice for centuries. Laminated rock maple holds the tuning pins securely, an idea we borrowed from piano construction.
